





LENGTH OF STUDY

Learners have



ONE YEAR within which to complete **each** exam.

This is taken from the date the application has been approved by the AIDT Board.



Should an extension be required, an email must be forwarded to the AIDT Board

Before entering for the Pre-Associate / Associate la exams:

A minimum of 6 SIX MONTHS must have lapsed, from the date the application was approved.



APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR LEARNERS





PRE-ASSOCIATE LEARNER



Application must be made **before** the Learner starts his/her training.

Learners must comply with the following:

Be 17 <u>years</u> of age or older

Candidates <u>must turn</u> (18) <u>years</u> of age by the date of their Practical Exam

Hold the following **AIDT Executant Exam Certificate**:

Elementary or Elementary Level (previously Silver Higher or Senior Level 1 Tap Dance) (previously Grand Major Hip Hop)

If the Learner holds the Level Exam Certificate, they must have received



Learners with qualifications from other Dance Associations will be evaluated individually to see if they may apply for Membership

ASSOCIATE 1A LEARNER



Application must be made **before** the Learner starts his/her training.

Learners must comply with the following:



Be **18 years of age** or older

Learners who are 17 years of age and have completed ALL their AIDT Executant exams, may apply provided they hold the NQF 4 Qualification, and they will be 18 years of age prior to their exam.

Hold the NQF 4 Qualification i.e. National Senior Certificate (NSC-Matric) or equivalent Learners may make application for exemption for this to the AIDT

Hold the following AIDT Executant Exam Certificate:

Elementary or Elementary Level (previously Silver Higher or Senior Level 1 Tap Dance) (previously Grand Major Hip Hop Dance)

If the Learner holds the Level Exam Certificate, they must have received



Learners with qualifications from other Dance Associations will be evaluated individually to see if they may apply for Provisional Membership







Self Study





Preparing for the exam

The Theory exam covers all the work contained in the Modules <u>and</u> Tasks.

Learners must be able to put their knowledge into practice i.e.

- Label Diagrams
- Recognize Dance Styles from Videos
- Know how Muscles work in Movement
- Identify Time Signatures and Musical Terminology from pieces of music

• The Theory Exam is done online, on dates set by AIDT Head Office




• Learners need a PC, laptop or Notebook to access exam



Learners must obtain a minimum of 60% in each section of their exam, including the Theory Exam

- Portfolio File and Tasks
 - 10% of Total
- Practical Exam: Demonstration of Syllabus
 - 30% of Total Mark
- Practical Exam: Teaching
 - 40% of Total Mark
- Theory Exam
 - 20% of Total Mark
- TOTAL = 100%

Successful Learners will receive their Report and Certificate electronically.



Successful Learners will be eligible to train and enter Candidates from Pre-Grade, up to and including, all the exams covered in the Associate / Advanced Associate exam.

A period of 6 SIX MONTHS must lapse **before** the Learner will be eligible to enter his/her own Candidates for the exams they are qualified to teach.

It is not necessary for them to teach <u>UNDER</u> another teacher, once qualified


